

Monthly Summary for Cabinet for the month of September, 2015 in respect of Ministry of Coal.**A. Principal Activities**

The core objectives of the Ministry of Coal are to augment coal production by adopting state-of-the-art clean-coal technologies; enhancing exploration efforts with thrust on increasing proven coal resources and developing necessary infrastructure for prompt evacuation of coal for securing its availability to meet the demand of different sectors of the economy in an eco-friendly and sustainable manner.

B. Important Decisions Taken During September, 2015

Under the provisions of the Coal Mines (Special Provisions) Act, 2015, Allotment Orders were issued, after receipt of Fixed costs, for 07 coal mines viz. Gare Palma Sector-III, Talaipalli, Chatti Bariatu & Chatti Bariatu South, Kerandari, Dulanga, Parsa and Gare Palma Sector-I and Vesting Orders were issued, after receiving the upfront amount, fixed costs and performance security, for 02 coal mines viz. Marki Mangli-I and Majra.

2. In addition, directions have been issued to Nominated Authority for allotment of Utkal D& E coal mines to M/s NALCO and Mandakini-B coal mine to M/s NTPC Ltd., under Rule 8 (2) (a) (ii) and Rule 11(1) of the Coal Mines (Special Provisions) Rules, 2014.

3. Further, a sum of Rs. 4,05,78,87,972 (Rs. Four hundred five crore seventy eight lakhs eighty seven thousand nine hundred seventy two only) was transferred to State Governments of Jharkhand, Odisha, Maharashtra, West Bengal, Madhya Pradesh & Chhattisgarh on account of 1st installment of upfront payment.

3. Promotional and Detailed drilling

Promotional Drilling: In Annual Plan 2015-16, a target of 1.75 lakh metre of Promotional drilling (0.988 lakh metre in coal and 0.762 lakh metre in lignite) had been envisaged. During the year 2015-16, the achievement of drilling upto the month of September, 2015 is 0.50 lakh metre.

Overall Progress of Detailed Drilling in 2014-15: For Annual Plan 2015-16, a target of 15.0 lakh metre of drilling (Departmental: 4.0 lakh metre, Outsourcing: 11.0 lakh metre) had been envisaged. As against this, 4.68 lakh metre of drilling has been carried out up to the month of September, 2015.

4. Initiatives to the Government's aim of 'Minimum Government Maximum Governance'.

Online coal project monitoring portal (e CPMP) has been launched to interact with all the stakeholders to resolve issues & avoid delay. All the coal companies are updating structural information on the portal.

To check theft & pilferage of coal, electronic monitoring of truck movement has been introduced in CIL/its subsidiaries through GPS/GPRS fitted on trucks with RFID based boom barriers, electronic Weigh bridges, CCTV surveillance & coal net. IT initiatives are under various stages of implementation as under:
