# Monthly Summary for the Cabinet for the month of April, 2018 in respect of Ministry of Coal

#### A.Principal Activities

The core objectives of the Ministry of Coal are to augment coal production by adopting state-of-the-art clean-coal technologies; enhancing exploration efforts with thrust on increasing proven coal resources and developing necessary infrastructure for prompt evacuation of coal for securing its availability to meet the demand of different sectors of the economy in an eco-friendly and sustainable manner.

## B.Important decisions taken during April, 2018

- 6th high power expert committee meeting was held on 05.04.2018 to examine efficacy and challenges of the current bidding system.
- 3rd meeting of Monitoring committee was held on 19.04.2018 to review the operationalization of coal mines allocated under the Coal Mines(Special Provisions) Act' 2015.
- 6th meeting of Scrutiny committee was held on 19.04.2018 to examine the submissions/replies made by Successful Bidders/Allottees of the coal mines in respect of deviation from the Efficiency Parameter as mentioned in the Coal Mine Development and Production Agreement.
- Allotment of KotreBasantpur and Pachmo Coal Mine to Central Coalfields Limited via allotment order no. F.No. NA-103/1/2017-NA dated 19.04.2018.
- Revenue generated in the month of April 2018 is Rs.85, 77, 29,447/-.
- Production in the month of March 2018 is 1.57 MT.
- Demand notice/Invocation notice issued for Appropriation of Bank Guarantees for total amount of Rs. 219,11,36,800/with respect to 7 coal mines namely Gare Palma IV/5 coal mine, SialGhogri coal mine, Kathautia coal mine, Gare
  Palma IV/4, Belgaon coal mine, Chotia coal mine and Sarisatolli coal mine.
- "The Coal Controller Organization has reported that the total production of Coal from the allocated captive coal blocks for the Month of April, 2018 is 3.276 Million Tonnes (Provisional). However, it is informed that out of the above mentioned coal production, coal production from coal blocks which have not been cancelled by the Hon'ble Supreme Court viz. Moher&MoherAmloriExtn., Tasra and PakriBarwadih is 1.704 Million Tonnes (Provisional).
- Directions of the Central government have been issued on 02.04.2018 for allotment of Barjora South Coal block to the Govt, company or corporation under section 11A(a) of MMDR Act read with 3(1)(b) of the Coal Blocks Allocation Rules, 2017 for the purpose of own consumption for generation of electricity through generating station.

Promotional Drilling: A programme of Promotional/NMET (Regional) drilling comprising 1.10 lakh meters in coal and 0.90 lakh meters in lignite has been drawn up in Annual Plan 2018-19 of CMPDI. The programme is under execution by MECL, DGMs of Nagaland & Assam and CMPDI. As against this, the achievement of drilling during the month of April, 2018 is 0.09 lakh metre, against the target of 0.11 lakh metre, registering a growth of 12% over the same period last year.

Overall Progress of Detailed Drilling in 2017-18: For 2018-19, a target of 13.00 lakh metre of drilling (Departmental: 4.80 lakh metre, Outsourcing: 8.20 lakh metre) has been envisaged. As against this, 1.16 lakh metre of drilling has been carried out during the month of April, 2018 against the target of 0.89 lakh metre, which is 131% of the target.
