Sub: Constitution of Inter-Ministerial Committee (IMC) under Rule 4(3) of 'Auction by Competitive Bidding of Coal Mines Rules, 2012' to consider the applications received from the Government companies – reg.

In pursuance of Rule 4(3) of 'the Auction by Competitive Bidding of Coal Mines Rules, 2012', framed under Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 an Inter-Ministerial Committee under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Coal) with the following members is constituted with the approval of Competent Authority.

2. The Committee shall co-opt the representatives of the concerned State Governments where the coal block and the end-use plant is / would be located.

3. The Terms of Reference (TOR) of the IMC shall be as under:

- i) to approve the proforma for inviting applications.
- ii) to recommend the eligibility criteria and parameters for evaluation of the applications in terms of weightages defined / decided prior to inviting the applications by the Government.

iii) to consider the applications received from the Government Companies for allocation of coal blocks on the basis of pre-determined criteria and to make recommendations after making comparative evaluation of the applications received.

iv) Any matter where a reference is made by the Competent Authority.

4. The IMC may deliberate and recommend the general principles / guidelines on the above issues. The IMC may also evolve procedure for conduct of its business for the above purpose.
