I am enclosing herewith the monthly report in respect of Ministry of Coal for the month of August, 2021:

- Overall coal production of CIL was 42.60 MT as compared to 37.16 MT i.e. a growth of 14.6% as compared to the corresponding month of last year.
- Overall coal offtake of CIL was 48.63 MT as compared to 44.40 MT i.e. a growth of 9.5% as compared to the corresponding month of last year.
- Coal dispatch by CIL to Power Sector was 38.61 MT as compared to 34.64 MT i.e. a growth of 11.4% as compared to the corresponding month of last year.
- The outstanding dues payable by Power Sector to CIL as on 31.08.2021 were ₹ 18,330.35 crore.
