FINAL ORDER

Subject: The Coal Mines (Special Provision) Act, 2015 and Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, judgment dated March 09, 2017 - Valuation of compensation payable to prior allottee M/s Goa Industrial Development Corporation, for Gare Palma Sector III coal mine.

Gare Palma Sector III coal mine was previously allotted to M/s Goa Industrial Development Corporation. After the cancellation of coal block in pursuant to the decision of Supreme Court of India, the said block/mine was allotted to M/s Chhattisgarh State Power Generation Company Limited vide Allotment order dated September 14, 2015 . The compensation for Cost of Geological Report, Cost of Consent, Land and Mine Infrastructure has been released to prior allottee vide Sanction letters, following the provisions of the Coal Mines (Special provisions) Act, 2015 [CMSP] and Rules framed there under, i.e., mentioned in the tabular form marked as Table 'A'

Accordingly, a total of INR **30,99,55,542.00/-** has been disbursed to the prior allottee till date.


