INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

1. Indo-Australia Collaboration:

Central Mine Planning & Design Institute Limited (CMPDI) has a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Commonwealth Scientific and Industrial Research Organisation (CSIRO), Australia signed on 12th June, 2013 for a period of five years for furthering scientific cooperation. The MoU has been renewed for further ten years, signed on 16th November, 2018 at Brisbane (Australia) and exchanged on 22nd November, 2018 at Sydney (Australia) in presence of Hon'ble President of India, to encourage programs of exchange and collaboration in areas of mutual interest and benefit to both the organizations.

R&D project funded by Coal India Limited (CIL) jointly implemented by CMPDI, CIL and CSIRO, Australia

The R&D project titled "Highwall Mining Feasibility Assessment and Layout Design" was approved by CIL in June 2022 and the project cost is ₹ 4.93 crore. CSIRO, Australia team visited 20 mines of different subsidiaries of CIL for the preliminary evaluation to identify the potential sites suitable for Highwall mining from 24th October 2022 to 9th November 2022. CSIRO submitted a "Preliminary Assessment of Highwall Mining Feasibility" report on 06.12.2022. The CSIRO team again visited CIL and different mines of Eastern Coalfields Limited (ECL), Bharat Coking Coal Limited (BCCL) & Central Coalfields Limited (CCL) to discuss different issues related to Highwall mining from 21st August 2023 to 31st August 2023 and two mines of CCL, namely Balkudra OCP & Kargali OCP were selected for Detailed Highwall layout design. Drilling of three boreholes at Balkudra

OCP was completed in December 2023 and physico-mechanical properties of the strata were provided to CSIRO in May 2024. Drilling of four boreholes at Kargali OCP was completed in January 2024 and physico-mechanical properties of the strata were provided to CSIRO in June 2024. Highwall Mining Layout Design for Balkudra OCP has been submitted by CSIRO in August 2024.

2. India-Canada Collaboration:

R&D project funded by CIL jointly implemented by CMPDI, ECL and Ergo Exergy Technology Inc. (EETI), Canada

The R&D project titled "A pilot project on Underground Coal Gasification (UCG) to establish Technology in Indian Geo-Mining condition" was approved by CIL in March 2024. The project started on 29.03.2024 and the project cost is ₹ 23.09 crore. Three hydrogeological wells and two deep-water sampling wells have been drilled and three shallow-water monitoring wells have been constructed. Geological modelling, Hydrogeological testing, Groundwater testing, Hydrogeological modelling, Rock mechanics testing, and Coal analysis have been completed. Three process wells are being drilled.
