Dear Sir,

With regard to significant activities of Ministry of Coal during March, 2025, information in respect of point no. (i) to (iii) specified in your DO letter No. 1/50/3/2024-Cab. dated 24.10.2024 is NIL and details on departmental indicators as per the format circulated vide your DO letter of even number dated 03.12.2024 is **Annexed**.

- 2. With respect to point no. (iv) ibid., regarding significant developments, I would like to inform that for the first time in the history of the coal sector in India, the production and supply of coal crossed the historic milestone of 1 Billion Tonnes in FY 2024-25. The overall production of coal in the country was 1047.39 MT in FY 2024-25 which is a growth of about 4.97% over the previous year. Similarly, the overall supply during FY 2024-25 was 1025.11 MT which is a growth of about 5.35% over the previous year. Despite certain logistics constraints on account of the Maha Kumbh, the coal stock at the Thermal Power Plants (TPP's) was at an all-time high of 55.48 MT on 31.03.2025 as compared to 47.78 MT on the same date last year which is a growth of 16.12%. At the level of current actual consumption, this stock is sufficient for 23 days.
- 3. Further, exploratory drilling operations in India's coal sector, through the Central Mine Planning & Design Institute Limited (CMPDIL) as the nodal agency of the Ministry of Coal, achieved a landmark 10.12 lakh meters in the fiscal year, surpassing the ambitious target of 10 lakh meters. This represents a 17% increase over 8.63 lakh meters drilled during the previous year, adding to the overall operational capacity of the sector and reflecting a firm commitment to meeting its demands.
- 4. It is also notable that Captive and Commercial coal mining blocks have produced about 190.95 MT of coal during FY 2024-25 which is a growth of 29.79% over last year. Imparting a further impetus to the growth

of this segment, Coal Mine Development and Production Agreements (CMDPA) have been signed for 9 coal blocks on 27th March, 2025 which were auctioned under the 11th round of Commercial coal mine auctions. Concurrently, the 12th round of Commercial coal mine auctions offering 28 identified coal and lignite blocks in 7 States have also been launched on the same date.

- 5. For the first time since independence scientific coal mine closure was accomplished in respect of 9 coal mines involving a comprehensive approach. A target of 43 mine closures have been kept for the current financial year.
- 6. The Coal PSUs under Ministry of Coal have also surpassed their annual CAPEX target for FY 2024-25 as the consolidated CAPEX achievement stands at ₹ 28,715.82 crore (prov) vis-a-vis the target of ₹ 22,048.86 crore i.e. 130.24% of the target. Coal India Limited has paid a dividend of ₹ 10,252.09 crore to the Government of India in FY 2024-25, which is the highest dividend paid on a cash basis among all CPSEs for the financial year 2024-25.
- 7. I am pleased to inform that Ministry of Coal has achieved the top position in the overall procurement through GeM among all the Central Ministries/Departments while Coal India Limited and its subsidiaries with a procurement value of ₹ 2,08,467.00 crore are at the top position in the overall procurement through GeM among all the CPSEs registering a growth of 108% over the procurement value of last year.
