This category includes projects under both private sector companies and government PSUs.

Launched on January 24, 2024, the Financial Incentive Scheme for Coal Gasification has a total outlay of ₹8,500 crore. The scheme aims to achieve 100 million tonnes of coal gasification by 2030, leveraging India's abundant domestic coal reserves to promote sustainable industrial development. It encourages participation from both public and private sector players to establish coal gasification projects across the country.

This initiative is a key component of India's clean coal transition strategy. It is expected to reduce environmental impact, enhance energy security, and drive economic growth through technological innovation and infrastructure development.

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
