**FINAL COMPENSATION ORDER-I**

**Subject:** Final determination of compensation for Cost of Geological Report, Consents, Land, and Mine Infrastructure payable to M/s Jayaswal Neco industries Limited (hereinafter referred to as 'JNIL') and M/s JSW Steel Limited (hereinafter referred to as 'JSW') in terms of the Coal Mines (Special Provisions) Act, 2015 and the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi's judgment dated March 9, 2017 – **regarding Moitra coal block.**

In pursuance of the Provisional Compensation Order – I issued on 24.06.2025, M/s Jayaswal Neco Industries Limited (prior allottee) and M/s JSW Steel Limited (successful allottee) were invited to attend a meeting on 30.06.2025 at 15:00 hrs to present their comments/objections, if any, regarding the compensation amount determined by the Office of the Nominated Authority.

**1. Meeting and Submissions:**

Both prior and successful allottees participated in the meeting held on 30.06.2025 (refer Annexure-I for the list of participants).

- i. The representative of JNIL expressed acceptance of the Provisional Compensation Order dated 24.06.2025 during the meeting and further confirmed the same through a written communication dated 25.06.2025.
- ii. The representatives of JSW accepted the Provisional Compensation Order dated 24.06.2025, subject to certain objections, while aligning with the Hon'ble Delhi High Court's judgment dated 09.03.2017. A formal written submission was also received from JSW via letter dated 27.06.2025, wherein it was informed that:

A. *JSW has challenged the impugned order (Final order dated 02.09.2022 as per CMSP Act) by way of filing an application under Sec 27 of the Coal Mines (Special Provisions) Act, 2015, before the District and Session Judge cum Tribunal Under CBA (A&D) Act, Ranchi ("Tribunal") constituted under the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957 at Ranchi Jharkhand on 01.03.2024. The said application has been numbered as CBC 9 of 2024 ("Application"). In the Application, JSW inter alia has raised the following issues:-*

1. *Issue of cheque bounce*

2. *Issue of excess Land*
3. *Issue of CA Land*

B. It was further confirmed by JSW that no stay has been granted by the Hon'ble Tribunal/Court on the compensation order.

## **2. Final Determination:**

The aforementioned objections raised by JSW were already considered and adjudicated through the Final Compensation Order dated 02.09.2022 (copy enclosed). As no new grounds have been raised, the compensation amount as determined under Provisional Compensation Order – I dated 24.06.2025 is hereby confirmed as final. A copy of the Provisional-I and Final Compensation Order is enclosed herewith for reference.

## **3. Payment Obligations:**

M/s JSW Steel Limited is hereby directed to deposit an amount of ₹3,63,47,465/- (Rupees Three Crore Sixty-Three Lakh Forty-Seven Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Five Only) into the designated account of the Ministry of Coal **within fifteen (15)** days from the date of receipt of this Order.

## **4. Dispute Resolution:**

Under Section 27 of the Act and in accordance with the judgment dated March 9, 2017, it is open to M/s Jayaswal Neco industries Limited and M/s JSW Steel Limited to raise disputes with regard to the quantum of compensation before the Tribunal constituted under the Coal Bearing areas (Acquisition and Development) Act 1957.
